About Pharm D

From current academic year SAL Institute of Pharmacy has started Pharm D program. The Pharm. D program is a professional doctor degree in pharmacy. The Pharm. D degree requires five years of classroom and hospital based study, followed by one year of internship or residency in addition to ongoing practical and research project. The Doctor of Pharmacy curriculum provides students with the scientific background and clinical skills to offer patient-centred, team-based care in an evolving health care system. It is introduced to improve clinical and hospital pharmacy services in India and it is the only pharmacy service which is in direct contact with the patient healthcare system and authorized to take critical decisions in in-patient prescription. The curriculum includes various specialized areas like clinical pharmacy, hospital and community pharmacy, pharmacotherapeutics, pharmacoepidemiology, pharmacoconomics, clinical research to name a few.
